In every class section students receive a course syllabus that specifies learning objectives consistent with those in the institution's officially approved course outline." - 5. Instructor's grading methodology and, as appropriate, grading rubric;
- 6. Titles of textbooks or other learning materials students are required to have for the course;
- 7. Listing of key assignments and projected due dates.
