<u>Significant Findings</u>: Significant Findings: Female vs. Male shows increasing completion disparity especially in the last two years of the report, with Males exceeding Females. African-Am shows chronically lower completion over the years of the report, especially when compared to the White and Hispanic categories, the two predominant ethnic populations at PVC.

<u>Conclusions and Next Steps</u>: Need to investigate further the Male vs. Female completion disparity, perhaps by first reviewing predominance of Males in the prisons participating in PVC's correspondence education program. Need further study in African Am completion particularly as it compares with PVC-wide and statewide performance in this area.
